Prosecco 'Brut' Conti D'Arco, Italy

£25.50

Prosecco is so popular these days, some with a fair bit of sugar in them, not this one, this is Brut – zero sugar, lovely aperitif start to lunch or supper.

Prosecco, Special Cuvee, Zonin, Italy 20cl

£8.50

A lovely small bottle to enjoy inside or out. Pale creamy notes with a balanced sparkle in the glass.

Brut, Road Green Sparkling 2016, Gloucestershire (vegan)

£47.00

A crisp dry sparkling wine made from Phoenix and Orion grapes by a tiny family producer near Stroud in Gloucestershire. Flavours of English hedgerow and elderflower with biscuit notes and a hint of orchard fruit.

Cava Rosado, Castellblanc, 'Brut' N/V Spain

£29.00

Is Cava a thing of the past, no definitely not, this is super lovely. Made in the 'Champagne Method' with red fruits and a superb balance between the fruit and the fizz, you will enjoy this immensely.

Gremillet Champagne 'Brut' N/V France

£45.00

This champagne shows fine mousse with classic doughy and floral aromas, which is balanced by ripe fruit and citrus and biscuity notes.

Laurent Perrier 'La Cuvée' 'Brut' France

£65.00

Founded in 1812, Laurent Perrier is considered one of the leading independent and family-owned houses. Drinks superbly!

Wines by Nature Rosado 'Organic' Spain

This is Organic & Vegan, made from the Tempranillo grape and more on the dry side with clean fresh cherries and raspberries in this mouth watering rose.

Organic Provence Rosé, Domaine Camaissette, France

When it has to be French Rose, it has to be from Provence, this lovely organic pale pink is very well balanced with wild strawberries and herbal notes.

Burlesque, Zinfandel Blush, USA

Pinot Grigio, Recchia 2019 Italy	£6.00	£8.15	£23.50
A lovely freshness and clarity of fruit in this juicy Pinot Grigio. This comes from the Veneto region in the North East of Italy from gently rolling vineyards.			
Pic poul de Pinet, Duc de Morny, Languedoc, France	£6.75	£8.75	£25.00
Grown around the pretty coastal Mediterranean village of Pinet, where the vineyards overlook oyster beds, unsurprisingly this is crisp, very moreish and lovely with seafood too.			
Viognier, Mas Bahourat, Pays D'Oc, 2019 France	£6.50	£8.50	£24.50
Another delicious Southern French aromatic white, grown on moderate altitude vineyards on the Pyrenees, adjacent to an apricot orchard which flavours mirror that of the Viognier grape.			
Chardonnay, Reserve St Martin, Pays D'Oc, France	£6.00	£8.15	£23.50
This lightly oaked Chardonnay is soft and ripe with pineapple and mango fruit flavours. Grown on cool Mediterranean vineyards bordering the Pyrennes.			
Sauvignon Blanc, Black Cottage, Marlborough, NZ	£7.00	£9.30	£27.50
We all love Marlborough Sauvignon, this is grown in coastal high altitude vineyards, which gives this wine a more European (Sancerre) feel. Minerals and citrus fruits a plenty here.			
Chenin Blanc, Lyngrove Estate, Stellenbosch, SA	£6.00	£8.00	£23.00
This is unoaked, and loaded with peaches and honey on the nose and palate, Grown near coastal False Bay which adds a crispness, lovely with most fish dishes, prawns and salmon.			
Coleridge Hill, Three Choirs, Gloucestershire, England			£24.50
Produced only 60 miles North of the pub on the English/Welsh border. English wines are no joke anymore, clean and impactful with moderate alcohol this is a lovely aperitif wine.			
Esprit Barville Blanc, Cotes-du-Rhone, 2019			£26.00
Made mainly with Grenache Blanc, famed for its full body and intense flavours of pear and citrus with hints of hedgerow flowers. This is the often unnoticed white of Southern France, but should be highlighted, excellent value for money and tastes rather good too.			
Albarino, Gran Fabian, Rias Baixas, Spain			£27.00
Grown in the North West corner in Spain comes this ripe peach laden white with a lovely mineral spritz, dry but not too overly dry, this works well with many fish courses.			
Morning Fog Chardonnay, Wente Vineyards, California, USA			£32.00
First established in 1883, Wente are one of the oldest family run wineries in the USA. Enticing nose of tropical and citrus fruits draw you in and the long satisfying finish of vanilla and toffee brings you back for another sip.			
Montagny 'Premier Cru' Bouchard Père et Fils, Burgundy, France			£38.00
An elegant and well balanced Montagny, made by the Bouchard family. An expressive nose of delicate yellow fruits with a touch of honey. The palate is precise, supple and savoury.

Aragonez/Castelão, Quinta da Bacalhoa, Lisbon, Portugal	£6.00	£8.00	£23.00
This lovely red is produced in the South of the country, a very warm climate which lends itself to ripe & rich bodied reds. Lovely with red meats or simply to sip on its own.

Passo Antico, Old Vine, Sardinia, Italy			
Something a little different, this comes from Sardinia, made in the appassimento method of partially using raisined grapes, very smooth & full of flavour but not overly heavy.			
Merlot, Reserve St Martin, Pays D'Oc, France	£6.00	£8.15	£23.50
Merlot is so popular because of its good texture & silky soft tannins, this has a touch of silky and plummy fruit, grown slightly inland to offer ripe fruit, very easy to enjoy.			
Pinot Noir, Les Volets, Aude Valley, France	£6.90	£8.90	£26.00
Something a bit different, and lighter in body not taste, grapes grown in Southern France, normally too warm for Pinot, but this is grown on the Pyrenees to temper the heat.			
Malbec, Atorrante, Mendoza, Argentina	£6.75	£8.75	£25.00
Atorrante means layabout in Spanish (a permanent member of the bar stool community). This is lightly oaked from mile high vineyards, which are irrigated from melted snow from the nearby Andes.			
Shiraz, Soldiers Block, Victoria, Australia			£25.00
Grown in cool Victorian vineyards around Melbourne, this Shiraz is not dark & heavy at all, you will find bright, juicy & aromatic fruit in here which make this highly drinkable.			
Monte Real Rioja Crianza, Monte Real, 2017 Spain			£26.00
This Crianza has spent 12 months ageing in French and American oak, giving this full bodied Northern Spanish red a vanilla laden taste with a long and satisfying finish.			
Malbec, Nuna Vineyards 'Organic' Argentina			£28.00
When we tasted this, this was a real standout, made from mile high vineyards with organic viticulture. Ripe and satisfying, light oak which shines the glorious fruit.			
Chianti Classico, Castello di Abola, Tuscany, Italy			£29.00
Pure Sangiovese from premium vineyards. This has some bottle age, and offers tannin maturity and a silky texture. Medium bodied and long-lasting finish.			
Cairanne, Domaine Grosset, Rhône, France			£28.00
Cairanne is a single appellation now. The single nearest wine to Chateauf-neuf-du-Pape at a fraction of the cost. Rich, mature and beguiling, this definitely satisfies the big red wine drinker.			
Barolo DOCG 'Ca Bianca' Piedmonte, Italy			£45.00
A complex nose of ripe strawberry, dried cherry and cinnamon spice with delicate floral and violet notes. Tannins are supple with rich fruit and a round silky texture and a lovely long finish.			
Mercurey 'Vieilles Vignes' François Raquillet, Burgundy, France			£49.00
Burgundy can be a very hot and miss, this wine is made from vines that are 65 yrs old which adds a lovely definition to the wine, enticing nose but the real quality is on the palate, silky with red fruits and warm spice with a lovely satisfying finish, leaving you wanting another glass!
