 This brilliant sixth generation estate makes fabulous sparkling wine in the traditional champagne method. The blend is Chenin Blanc, Chardonnay and the local indigenous grape Mauzac. Soft elegant celebratory bubbles! **£10.00**

Crémant de Limoux Rosé 'Cuvée Emotion' 2023 Domaine Antech 175ml £42.00
 The addition of a little Pinot Noir gives the wine a very pale pink hue. **£10.00**
 The end result is fresh, refined flavours with a hint of red fruit characters. A delight!

Gremillet Champagne 'Brut' N/V France £64.00
 This champagne shows fine mousse with classic doughy and floral aromas, which is balanced by ripe fruit and citrus and biscuity notes.

Taittinger Brut Reserve N.V. £85.00
 This famous Champagne House needs little introduction. Delicacy and refinement is what it is associated with. Made from the classic blend of the three champagne grapes, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier

Champagne Bara Grand Rosé de Bouzy N.V. £78.00
 This has to be one of the best value 'under the radar' pink champagnes available. Made entirely with Pinot Noir from 100% Grand Cru designated vineyards. Wild red fruits on the nose and palate abound. Very classy...as simple as that!

Triennes Rosé 2025 Provence, Var £10.00 £12.00 £35.00
 This estate has developed into being one of the most highly regarded Rosé producers. Cinsault is the predominant grape and the nett result is a pale pink wine with a bouquet of strawberries and wild flowers and a tangy fresh flavour

Coquille de Fleur Rosé, 2025 Languedoc £9.50 £12.00 £32.00
 Light and fresh, with fruit-forward aromas. Notes of wild raspberry and candied strawberry. The palate is lively and well-balanced, with mineral elements echoing on the finish

Mourvèdre Rosé 2026, Babylonstoren, Cape Wineland Vineyard, South Africa £12.00 £16.00 £46.00
 This elegant dry rosé is made in the Provence style by Babylonstoren's talented winemakers. Using sun-kissed Mourvèdre grapes. The wine offers a delicately fruity profile. Aromatic notes of raspberry, strawberry and rose rise on the bouquet, while hints of rhubarb, pomegranate and ripe watermelon show on the palate

CYDER - THE NEWT, SOMERSET

Wyvern Wing, 8%, Somerset 75cl bottle £18.00

A delicious pale straw coloured cyder made from Braeburn apples with aromas of green apple, gooseberry and lime. It is an ideal pre-dinner aperitif or an elegant companion to grilled fish, scallops, and smoked chicken salads.

No 3 Yarlington Mill, 5%, Somerset 75cl bottle £16.00

A more traditional medium gold coloured cyder with a baked apple & gooseberry aroma and a smooth, rich, sweet tannin cyder with a great fruity start and a dry finish. A perfect every day drinking cyder

Signature Blend, 5.5% Somerset 375ml bottle £10.00

A medium dry signature blend cyder is made with over 20 varieties of apples harvested from The Newt's Orchard's. Ripe bittersweet apple with hints of smoke and a lingering liquorice finish

Chardonnay, Chemin des Oliviers 2024, France £9.50 £12.00 £32.00

This unoaked chardonnay from south-west France offers excellent varietal characters and is a delight whether drunk on its own or with a first course, white meat and poultry

Pic poul de Pinet, Duc de Morny, Languedoc, France £9.50 £12.00 £34.00

Grown around the pretty coastal Mediterranean village of Pinet, where the vineyards overlook oyster beds, unsurprisingly this is crisp, very moreish and lovely with seafood too.

Viognier, ' Selon Letang' Vin de France 2025, France £9.00 £11.00 £32.00

This wine has a ripe apricot character, soft acidity and a highly pleasant flavour profile. Grown in the near perfect conditions in the South of France.

Grillo, Enologica Cassara, 2025 Sicily £9.50 £11.50 £32.00

Sicilian wines are becoming all the rage, both red and white. This white, made from the Grillo grape is dry, light, fresh with a savoury/saline character. This matches seafood really well and cheese dishes or is a delight just enjoyed on its' own

Muerza Rioja Blanco, 2025 £9.50 £12.00 £33.00

The nose has aromas of conference pear, white flowers and some limey notes. Fresh, clean and crisp in the mouth with good length and balance. Unoaked, fresh, vibrant and easy drinking

Huia Sauvignon Blanc 2024, Marlborough, New Zealand

£37.00

This is not your archetypal NZ Sauvignon as it has been aged for twelve months in old neutral oak casks. This 'broadens out' the wine a little. It still has that lovely herbaceous character but the ageing makes it work with food better. So versatile...works well with almost any first course or fish dish

Godello 2024 C.V.N.E Pagos de Galir, Valdeorras, Spain

£45.00

From one of Spain's most famous wine estates this is a fascinating wine. Grown at altitude in Galicia it is partially fermented in stainless steel and partly in barrel. The nett result is flavours of citric fruits and wild herbs with a refreshing touch of salinity. Ideal with fish dishes, white meats and cheese.

Macon-Villages 2023 Domaine Alexis Pollier, Burgundy, France

£45.00

With ever increasing burgundy prices (although the demand is still there) the wines from the Maconnais continue to offer great value. The quality has also rocketed in recent years as well. Here we have beautifully pure ripe unoaked Chardonnay from the excellent 2022 vintage. Excellent white burgundy at the price.

Foxglove Chardonnay 2019, Varner Wines, California, USA.

£46.00

Brothers Jim and Bob Varner have built themselves a reputation for producing with freshness, varietal characteristics, minimal use of oak intervention and value! What could be better! This wine is similar to the Macon above but a touch richer having been enhanced with a touch of oak and Californian sunshine! Ideal to match rich terrines/pâtés and white meat dishes

Chablis 2024, Domaine Bernard Defaix

£54.00

Our vines on the appellation Chablis spread over 12 hectares, situated at the heart of the Chablisian vineyard. This wine is aged in stainless steel tanks so as to respect the typicity of the appellation. The bouquet displays a dominance of mineral notes, which are often associated with delicate touches of citrus fruit (lemon and grapefruit). Chablis goes well with white fish and seafood dishes especially oysters

Pouilly-Fumé 2024 Domaine Treuillet, Loire Valley, France

£49.00

Quite simply, we modestly say this is drop-dead gorgeous Pouilly-Fumé! Grown on limestone and flinty clay the wine is aged in stainless steel to emphasise its vibrancy, minerality and floral character. Perfect with fish dishes and white meats

Assyrtiko 2024, Vassaltis Estate, Santorini

£61.00

The wines of Santorini are truly in vogue and rightly so. The beauty of the Assyrtiko grape is that even in a hot climate it does not lose its acidity. The wine has a wonderful mouthfeel, real texture created by the volcanic soils that the vines are grown in and a wonderful fresh saline character. An ideal partner to seafood dishes and quite an experience!

Bourgogne Blanc 'Les Sétilles' 2022 Olivier Leflaive. Burgundy, France

£75.00

This is really classy white burgundy from one of the most respected producers of the region. Their wines higher up the ladder cost hundreds of pounds but this 'entry' level wine offers what good white burgundy is all about without breaking the bank

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Côtes de Thongue, France

This is the most versatile easy-drinking soft, juicy Merlot. No oak here, just lovely medium-weight fruit.

Atance Bobal 2022, Valencia, Spain

	£9.00	£11.00	£32.00
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Bobal is the grape, local to the region. Having been grown at high altitude the wine has delightful freshness and 'crunchiness'. This could be described as Spain's equivalent to Beaujolais...medium-weight and works perfectly with almost any white or red meats dishes

Shiraz, Soldiers Block, Victoria, 2024 Australia

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Grown in cool Victorian vineyards around Melbourne, this Shiraz is not dark & heavy at all, you will find bright, juicy & aromatic fruit in here which make this highly drinkable.

Nero d'Avola 'Tre Filari' 2022, Enologica Cassara, Sicily

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Another wine from Sicily that really over- delivers. With more weight and spice than the two reds above it is an ideal match for red roasts and grills.

Pinot Noir, Les Volets, Aude Valley, France

Something a bit different, and lighter in body not taste, grapes grown in Southern France, normally too warm for Pinot, but this is grown on the Pyrenees to temper the heat.

Chateau Tour de Biot 2022, A.C Bordeaux, France

This is an inexpensive Bordeaux that offers an awful lot for the money! Proper claret from a great vintage. From the right bank of the river and made from 60% Merlot and balanced out with Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc. Perfect for strong gutsy flavours.

Rioja Crianza 'Zeledonio' 2022

Bodegas Domeco de Jaruata, Spain.

This Rioja has been aged in oak but it is more fruit-driven than wood-dominated. A wine that really delivers a bang for your buck. Another wine that will match well with well flavoured red meat dishes.

Uco Valley Malbec 2024, Magna Montis, Argentina

£11.00 £13.00 £35.00

The key here is high altitude resulting in freshness in the fruit. This wine is a world away from the gloopy, overripe caricature of Argentinian Malbec. No use of wood here...the wine is raised in concrete tanks and the result is a delight!

Côtes-du-Rhône 2023, Nicolas Boiron, Rhone Valley, France

£39.00

This is fabulous big juicy fruit from one of the top producers in Châteauneuf-du-Pape..... Nicolas Boiron, sixth generation owner of Domaine Bosquet-des-Papes...just delicious!

Château Maison-Neuve 'Cuvée Alexia' 2020 A.C. Blaye-Côtes de Bordeaux

£41.00

Named after the proprietor and winemaker Alexia Eymas, this Bordeaux, from the Right Bank some fifteen miles north of the town of Blaye is a tremendous find and great value. Made from a blend of Merlot and Malbec it was raised entirely in tank and whilst offering all the classic claret characteristics it maintains freshness and perfect balance.

Another red to enjoy with red meat dishes or strong flavoured pasta dishes.

Moulin-à-Vent 'Cuvée de Thorins' 2023 Château de Moulin-à-Vent, Beaujolais, France

£44.00

Everyone seems to head to Fleurie when it comes to Beaujolais so we are steering you away to another of the ten villages or 'Cru' as they are known.

Made entirely from the Gamay grape it is a combination of red-style fruits with a touch of blue fruit characters as well....beautifully pure elegant flavours.

Babel 2024, Stellenbosch, western Cape, South Africa, Babylonstoren £48.00

48% shiraz, 13% merlot, 11% petit verdot, 10% malbec, 10% cabernet franc & 7% pinotage.

A delicious bouquet of crushed mulberry, blackberry & plum with layers of sweet spice, vanilla & dark chocolate. Perfect with spiced pork, lamb and rich stews

Mercurey 'Vieilles Vignes' 2020, Domaine Charton. £65.00

The wines from this village and others in the Côte Chalonnaise at the southern end of Burgundy have grown from strength to strength in recent years yet have still maintained relatively sensible pricing. A lighter style of wine offering versatility to partner well flavoured fish dishes and both red and white meat and poultry.

**Châteauneuf-du-Pape 'Cuvée Tradition' Domaine Bosquet-des-Papes, 2022 £69.00
Rhône Valley, France**

Made predominately from the Grenache grape with a splash or two of Syrah, Mourvèdre, Vaccarèse, Counoise and Cinsault the wine packs a punch but is actually elegant, fresh and with 'lifted' fruit with layer after layer on the palate. Drink with either red or white meat dishes.

Barolo 'Cascina' Nuova' Elvio Cogno, Piedmont, Italy 2020 £72.00

This renowned 15 hectare estate has been taken to new levels

The wine oozes elegance and finesse with silky, soft, 'lacey' tannins and one could be forgiven for thinking you are drinking Pinot Noir not Nebbiolo.

This is a wine that over-delivers massively when it comes to quality/price.

**Nebukadnesar 2023, Simonsberg Mountain, Western Cape, South Africa £77.00
Babylonstoren**

A lovely intense nose of violets and thyme with blackcurrants. A beautiful full bodied wine with layers of dark red fruits supported by light, well honed tannins. Opulent and sophisticated. Perfect with lamb and beef

Margaux du Château Margaux, 2019 £86.00

This is the third wine from the legendary Chateau Margaux estate...one of the five great 'first growth' wines from Bordeaux. More accessible than the 'grand vin' it offers wine enthusiasts a gateway into the world of Chateau Margaux, renowned for its elegance and finesse.

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Blended apples & brandy matured in oak barrels producing a warming digestif with a lovely lingering aftertaste - Perfect pairing with cheese

Banyuls 'Bila-Haut', 2021 16% 500ml	£12.00	£44.00
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Vin Doux Naturel Rouge, Maison Chapoutier

From the very far south-west of France close to the Spanish border this red wine made from the Grenache grape is the perfect partner to dark chocolate dishes and strong salty cheeses. Would also work well with summer pudding, panna cotta or just poured over vanilla ice cream!

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Monbazillac, Domaine de Grange Neuve, France	£11.00
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The vineyards are located in Bergerac, the home of foie gras. Lovely intense flavours, apricot & marmalade. This is a touch lighter than Sauternes which represents excellent value

Carmes de Rieussec 2017 14% 375ml	£9.00	£26.00
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Les Carmes de Rieussec is the excellent second wine from the iconic Château Rieussec in Sauternes, owned by Domaines Baron de Rothschild (Lafite). 2017 is a blend of Sémillon 94%, Sauvignon blanc 3%, Muscadelle 3% and is a pure, bright and energetic Sauternes with notes of citrus and stone fruit, with added tangerine and candied melon undertones.

This may not be one of the famous names of Sauternes but it has to be the best value for quality....a great discovery. Dried apricot and quince leaps from the glass, sweet but not cloying and fresh on the finish. An ideal partner to fruit-based desserts and salty and blue cheeses.
